COVID-19 PROTOCOLS AT TLC

To resume operations as a non-essential business we have the following requirements:

- Reservations only, no walk-ins
- 1 household per cabin, non-household members prohibited from sharing a cabin
- Employees are required wear face mask or fabric covering at all times in common areas
- Only 1 guest with a face mask or fabric covering allowed in the office at check-in with 1 staff member
- Acknowledged and signed health and travel questionnaire before reservation is completed. To be kept on file for 30 days
- Hand sanitizer and paper towel will be available for use during check-in.
- All touch points will be sanitized after each guest check-in.
- CDC guidelines will be followed for cleaning, disinfecting and sanitizing cabins after guests have checked-out
